### Make a Direct Impact Through Camp Sponsorship

Camp sponsorships allow businesses and organizations to make a direct impact, both on the lives of traumatized grieving and children, and on how their lives will touch our community for a lifetime. Sponsorships also provide multiple volunteer opportunities for employees, allowing them to be an integral part of your organization's charitable giving. Each camp includes up to 65 camper families and 90 volunteers.

### **About Camp**

Each camp costs us **\$55,000** and includes facility rental, all food and supplies for approximately 150 people over three days, travel costs and travel scholarships, parent lodging, volunteer training, and the extensive screening and matching process for campers and volunteers, performed by our program staff. The screening process begins 8-12 weeks prior to camp and facilitates both the Healing Circle<sup>SM</sup> groupings (age-based support groups for grief counseling) at camp, and the Little Buddy/Big Buddy pairings between campers and volunteers.

Our camp staff spends 3-4 hours per child interviewing family, guardians, counselors, therapists and any others who have direct insight into each camper's emotional health and grief journey. During this time, volunteers are also screened and submit to background and reference checks. Once approved, each volunteer receives six hours of childhood bereavement and camp training.

The Healing Circle and Little Buddy/Big Buddy matching process begins three weeks prior to camp. Healing Circles are determined in part by age, loss type and compatibility, while Big Buddy matches are based on the specific needs of each camper and the volunteer's ability to meet those needs as a support system – not as therapist. Campers often come to camp starved for both attention and validation because their parent or guardian is consumed with handling his or her own grief; the 1:1 Comfort Zone pairing model ensures that the child receives both support and validation throughout camp. The camp weekend offers a prescriptive blend of traditional camp activities, trust building activities, mentorship and grief counseling.

Healing Circles not only change the grief journeys of 65 children, this powerful resource changes the way their lives touch our communities forever.

# Gift of Love, \$10,000

The Gift of Love covers all of the costs associated with recruiting, screening, training, matching and providing for up to 90 volunteers for a single 3-day weekend camp. Up to 65 of these volunteers will serve as Big Buddy mentors, and the remaining volunteers fill roles required for camp to run smoothly, including camp nurse, art teacher, general volunteers and other positions.
